



# CLOZAPINE AND CONSTIPATION


# THREE TIMES:

**SIXTY PERCENT:** 

Constipation 3 times more likely with clozapine than other antipsychotics


Between 30% and 60% of patients on

clozapine experience constipation



# **ONSET EARLY:**

The onset of constipation is often but not exclusively within the first 4 months




# OVER 60's ↑ RISK:

Other risk factors include Obesity, High clozapine doses, Dehydration, Hypothyroidism


# LIFE THREATENING:

Mortality rates in severe constipation are 20-30%, with a 7 fold increase in fatal ileus




# LIFESTYLE:

Increase exercise, dietary fibre and fluid intake




### **OBSERVE**:

Bowel charts and food and fluid charts can help with the early identification of constipation




## **ORAL LAXATIVES:**

Softening: Laxido, Lactulose Stimulating: Senna, Dulcolax



### SEEK HELP:

The ward or duty medics are always available. In serious cases, specialist advice may be required



#### ENEMA:

Glycerin suppositories and sodium picosulphate enemas are an option in severe cases
