

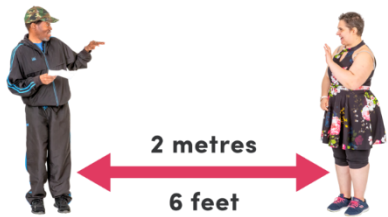
	<p>During the Coronavirus pandemic the Government made rules to stop people from catching Coronavirus.</p>
	<p>The rules in England changed on the 19th July 2021.</p>
	<p>Derbyshire Healthcare Foundation Trust want to keep some rules in place in our buildings to make sure everyone is still safe.</p>

When you attend an appointment you should:

	<p>Wear a mask when you are inside.</p>
	<p>Not everyone can wear a mask. This is called being exempt. This could be because they have a medical condition.</p>



If you have been told that you do not have to wear a mask you might like to wear a sunflower lanyard or carry an exemption card.



By wearing a sunflower lanyard other people will know to give you plenty of space.



Keep 2 metres apart from people who you do not live with or who support you.



Wash your hands or use hand sanitiser.



Walk on the left side of corridors.



In some of the buildings there will be arrows telling you which way to walk. Follow these arrows when you can.



You should only bring **one person** with you to your appointment.
