Grants and Benefits

Government Funding paid automatically

Energy Bills Support Scheme

Every household will receive £400 off their electricity bill, in six instalments, starting October 2022

Winter Fuel Payment

You should receive this at state pension age, but sometimes you need to apply. Call 0800 731 0160 if you are eligible and not in receipt

Warm Home Discount

You are eligible for a one-off payment, added as credit to your bill, if you receive the 'Guarantee Credit' portion of 'Pension Credit'

Cold Weather Payment

Paid if the average temperature in your area is recorded as, or forecast to be 0°C or below over seven consecutive days

Cost of Living Payment

You may be eligible if you're getting certain benefits or tax credits and will be paid automatically

Offers & Discounts

£1 meals for children under **16** at **Asda**, no minimum adult meal spend until end of 2022 **A free meal for one child under 16**, minimum adult meal spend of £4.99 at **Morrisons**Weekly discount of **10% off for people over 60** at **Iceland** on Tuesdays

Support from your water or energy company

Severn Trent Water can set up a payment plan or may offer a reduction. Call **0345 7500 500** (Monday to Friday, 8am to 8pm) and ask about the Big Difference Scheme

United Utilities can support customers in North West Derbyshire - call 0800 072 6765

South Staffs Water cover some areas of South Derbyshire - call 0800 093 0610

Speak to your energy provider if you're struggling - they have a duty to offer an affordable payment plan or provide emergency credit if you use a prepay meter
