

# Health Risk Assessment guidance – once Occupational Health advice is received

If you have had a Health Risk Assessment and have received feedback from Occupational Health, you need to add that feedback to the Health Risk Assessment form.

Liaise with your line manager to record findings and recommendations on the jointly written plans. Please complete the following:

Occupational Health review

OH advice date

Upload a file  No file chosen

Our findings and recommendations are

Line manager and employee outcome meeting review of OH advice and operational / situation changes

In conjunction with your line manager, you will then need to choose one of the following outcomes:

- Green – return to work with a risk reduction plan and any necessary adaptations
- Amber – work from home for a further four weeks and then review
- Red – this reflects a colleague on the shielded list, who needs to remain at home

<b>Return to work with risk reduction plan including the following outcomes, with any adaptations.</b>	<b>Work from home for a further 4 weeks and review at 4 weekly intervals.</b>	<b>Shielded list.</b>
	This will include some visits to non covid + areas to keep in touch, following strict social distancing.	Remain at home until national policy reviews this decision.
